

- P. 1, 8th line from bottom, starting "be the only": delete the comma.
 7th line from bottom, starting "of interpreting"; read: of interpreting Aristotle as holding it. (Phenomenology . . . , etc.
- P. 198, 19th line from bottom, starting "are quantified variables": change Ex to $\exists x$.
 16th line from bottom, starting "meaning of 'exists'": add a comma after "circularly".
- P. 199, 21st line, starting "existents."; read: existents:
- P. 199, 3rd paragraph, starting "Every predicate", indent the whole paragraph (a quotation).
- P. 200, 6th line, starting, "the 'something' in"; read: that the something in the existential quantification, "There is something such that it is a . . . musician,"
